“It’s a great honour for us to be a finalist,” says T. Harv Eker, President of Peak Potentials Training. “Being recognized as a finalist just underlines our principle that when your goal is to make a difference in this world, you’ll be rewarded.”

Members of the Awards' Board of Distinguished Judges and Advisors and their staffs selected International Stevie winners from among the finalists, which were determined by volunteer judges around the world during two months of preliminary judging.
